COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 694, L.D. 876, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize the Issuance of Free Fishing Permits to
Patients in Regular Nursing Homes."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §2401-B, sub-§6, as repealed and replaced by PL
1971, c. 622, §41, is repealed and the following enacted in its
place:

6. Free permits for inmates and patients at state institutions,
nursing homes and boarding homes. The commissioner is authorized
to issue free fishing permits covering groups of patients or
inmates at any state institution under the control of the
Department of Mental Health and Corrections, full-time patients
at a nursing home, or full-time residents of a boarding home as
defined and licensed under Title 22, section 5. Any such permits
shall be issued on request of the head of any such state institution,
nursing home or boarding home and shall be effective while such
groups are being conducted by a representative of the institution,
nursing home or boarding home of which any such patients or
inmates are residents and while such groups are fishing within a
25-mile radius of the institution, nursing home or boarding home
of which such patients or inmates are residents.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would authorize the issuance of free fishing
permits to groups of full-time residents of boarding homes.
