COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 278, L.D. 891, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Announcing the Moosehead Lake Region."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'23 MRSA §1201, sub-§13 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

13. Moosehead Lake Region. Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike at the first reasonable opportunity northerly from the York exit and shall be worded as follows:

Moosehead Lake region - Squaw Mountain - 4 1/2 hours.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the intent of the legislation by assuring that it is erected on the Maine Turnpike.
