## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Announcing the Moosehead Lake Region.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 13 is amended to read:

13. Moosehead Lake Region: Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike not more than one mile northerly from the Kittery exit and shall be worded as follows:

Moosehead Lake region — Squaw Mountain — 41/2 hours.

This bill would provide for a sign on the Maine Turnpike near the Kittery exit announcing the Moosehead Lake Region.
