HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 280, L.D. 893, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Power of Podiatrists."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'§3551. Definitions

The practice of podiatry is defined as the diagnosis and treatment of the human foot by medical, mechanical or surgical means without the use of anesthetics, except that: The administration and use of local anesthesia shall be permitted by those podiatrists who have been granted a doctorate degree from a school approved by the examiners; or the use of local anesthesia may be used in conjunction with the practice of podiatry by those podiatrists who have not been granted a doctorate degree from a school approved by the examiners when it is administered by a medical or osteopathic physician who assumes responsibility for the administration of anesthesia to a patient being treated by such a podiatrist; or the use of general anesthesia shall be permitted in conjunction with the practice of podiatry when it is administered by a medical or osteopathic physician who assumes responsibility for the administration of that anesthesia to a patient being treated by a podiatrist. For the purposes of this section a podiatrist is defined as one who administers only such treatment to the human foot. The words "podiatrists" and "chiropodist," "podiatry" and "chiropody" shall be construed to be synonymous.'
