# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Provide for the Purchase of Certain Town Histories.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Library; appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$2,645 to be used to purchase 75 copies of certain town histories. The breakdown shall be as follows:
