STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide that Committees of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine and Maine Maritime Academy are Governed by the Right-to-Know Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

I MRSA § 402, sub-§ 2, ¶ B, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 758, is amended to read:

B. Any board or commission of any state agency or authority, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine, including its committees and subcommittees, and the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy, including its committees and subcommittees; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is to clarify the "Right-to-know" law by explicitly making it applicable to committees and subcommittees of boards and commissions of any state agency, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine and the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy.
