AN ACT to Reduce Resident Hunting License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to reduce resident hunting license fees as follows: For a resident hunting license, for persons 16 years of age or older, from \$7.50 to \$6.50 and for a resident combination hunting and fishing license, from \$12.50 to \$10.50.
