HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 302, L.D. 928, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Sign on Interstate 95 Announcing Peaks-Kenny State Park."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'23 MRSA §1201, sub-§29 is enacted to read:

29. Peaks-Kenny State Park. Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike southerly of exit 15 and shall be worded as follows:

Peaks-Kenny State Park - I-95 - Newport Exit'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a sign on the Maine Turnpike directing motorist to Peaks-Kenny State Park.
