AN ACT to Establish a Sign on Interstate 95 Announcing Peaks - Kenny State Park.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 29 is enacted to read:

29. **Peaks - Kenny State Park.** The sign shall be constructed and maintained on Interstate 95 no less than 2 miles southerly from the Newport and Detroit exit and shall be worded as follows:

Peaks - Kenny State Park

Route 7

Newport Exit

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would provide for a sign on Interstate 95 near the Newport-Detroit exit indicating Peaks - Kenny State Park.
