**AN ACT Repealing the Requirement that a Buyer or Seller of Real Property
must file a Declaration of Value with the State Tax Assessor.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 4641-D, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 572, § 1, and as amended, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal this section so that it would no longer be necessary for the buyer or seller of real property to file a declaration of value with the State Tax Assessor.
