**AN ACT to Exempt Agricultural Societies from Camping License Requirements for Activities during Annual Fairs.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

22 MRSA § 2492, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 496, § 3, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence the following new sentence :

No license shall be required for camping area operations by an agricultural society licensed by the Commissioner of Agriculture under Title 7, section 65, so long as those operations are conducted by that society on grounds owned or leased by it, and no more than one week before or after the dates for its annual fair as assigned by its license from the commissioner.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt a licensed agricultural society from the requirement of obtaining a camping area license during its annual fair.
