STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Exempting Cooperatives From Registration as Dealers in Securities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 13. MRSA § 2006 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- § 2006. Registration as dealers in securities

Associations heretofore and hereafter organized under this chapter shall not be subject to Title 32, chapter 13.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Approximately 16 active fish marketing cooperatives exist in the State of Maine and by the special nature of this State's statutes, stock may be made available only to those engaged in the fishing industry as defined by State statute. The distribution of profits of these cooperatives is restricted to only those stockholders that qualify as being in the fisheries business. The protection of the Blue Sky laws registration does not exist with this type of corporation.
