COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 745, L.D. 950, "AN ACT
to Provide Voluntary Teacher Certification."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'The State Board of Education, pursuant to sections 859 and
911, may authorize the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural
Services to establish standards for the certification of
teachers of children under 5 years of age. The commissioner
is authorized to apply these standards only upon the request
of a teacher seeking certification.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that any
certification standards authorized by the State Board/^{of Education}for
teachers of children under 5/^{years of age}are to be applied only on a
voluntary basis upon the request of a teacher.
