AN ACT to Provide Voluntary Teacher Certification.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 59, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 551, § 1, is amended by inserting after the second sentence the following new sentence to read:

The State Board of Education pursuant to sections 859 and 911 may authorize the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services to certify teachers of children under 5 years of age.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for voluntary certification for teachers of children under 5 years of age.
