IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Registration of Voters on Election Day in all Polling Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 21 MRSA § 631, sub-§ 1, 2nd sentence, as amended by PL 1973, c. 782, § 8, is further amended to read:

He shall accept registrations in person on election day at all polling places within the municipality, but not on the business day next prior to it.

Sec. 2. 21 MRSA § 631, sub-§ 2, 2nd sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 414, § 26, is further amended to read :

He shall accept registrations in person on election day at all polling places within the municipality, but not on the 3 business days next prior to it.

Sec. 3. 21 MRSA § 631, sub-§ 3, 2nd sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 414, § 26, is further amended to read :

He shall accept registrations in person on election day at all polling places within the municipality, but not on the 5 business days next prior to it.

Sec. 4. 21 MRSA § 631, sub-§ 4, 2nd sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 414, § 26, is further amended to read :

He shall accept registrations in person on election day at all polling places within the municipality, but not on the 7 business days next prior to it.
