# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Create a Maximum Security Facility for Those Adjudged not Guilty of a Crime by Reason of Insanity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 34 MRSA § 2106 is enacted to read :

§ 2106. Operation of a Forensic Mental Health Unit

The Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections shall cause to be operated as part of the Bangor Mental Health Institute a unit physically designed and staffed to provide maximum security for the people of this State and for the patients being treated therein. Such unit shall serve as a setting for the diagnosis, observation, care and treatment of all persons committed to the custody of the commissioner, pursuant to Title 15, sections 101, 103 or 105 and Title 17-A, section 1251, subsection 2, and may serve as a setting for the diagnosis, observation, care and treatment of any person admitted to the institute pursuant to chapter 191.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bangor Mental Health Institute, Department of Mental Health and Corrections, the sum of \$250,000 in order to provide for necessary expenditures in connection with the establishment and operation of a Forensic Mental Health Unit in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978, as set forth in Section 1 of this Act.
