HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 769,
L.D. 960, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to State Liquor Identification
Cards."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last 6 lines
before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the
following:

'The application form shall include, directly above the signature
line, the following notice to the applicant: "I understand
that false statements made on this form are punishable by
law. Knowingly supplying false information on this form is
a Class D offense under the Criminal Code, punishable by confinement
of up to one year or by monetary fine of up to \$500 or by both."

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the warning concerning furnishing
of false information on the liquor identification card application,
and corrects the penalty.
