COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 775, L.D. 964, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Conservation Restrictions."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the underlined
paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'A land conservation trust is defined as a corporation
without capital stock organized under Title 13, chapter 81 or
any other nonprofit corporation law of this state whose purposes
include acquiring conservation easements to be held for the
benefit of the public.'

This amendment makes the language in the bill consistent
with the intent.
