HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 928, L.D. 968, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Borrowing Capacity of the Fort Fairfield Utilities District and to Provide for the Imposition of Liens to Secure Payment of Sewer Rates of the District."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end of section 2 the following underlined paragraph:

'Unless and until such time as all districts engaged in providing sewer service are placed under the general regulatory jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission, the only rates of the district subject to the approval of the Public Utilities Commission under this section are those for water service.'

## Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to include a provision in the bill that was inadvertantly left out.

This provision indicates that the Public Utilities
Commission has jurisdiction over water service, but not sewer
service.
