COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 306, L.D. 976, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Prevention of Alcohol Abuse."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§7125." by striking out subsection 2

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§7125." in subsection 4 by striking out the first sentence and inserting in its place the following:

The director shall submit interim reports prior to March 1st to the Second Regular session of the 108th Legislature and the First Regular Session of the 109th Legislature and a final report to the First Regular Session of the 110th Legislature.

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§7125." by striking out subsection 5

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by renumbering sections 3 and 4 to be 2 and 3

Further amend the Bill after section 1 by inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Plan submitted. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Act, the department shall submit a plan to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional Services which shall include a description of the procedures to be used in selecting project sites and the approaches to alcohol abuse prevention which are to be used in any projects selected.'

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Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 2 to be section 3.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

- Provide that the department submits a plan for carrying out the Act to the Health and Institutional Services Committee within 30 days of the effective date;
- Require that the department present a report to the 2nd
 Regular Session of this Legislature;
- 3. Delete a requirement that the department assist municipalities in preparing project proposals; and
- 4. Delete a requirement that the department consult with 2 other government agencies.
