SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 770, L.D. 977, Bill, "AN ACT to Redescribe the Boundary Line between the City of Brewer and the Towns of Orrington and Holden."


Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out in the 12th and 13th lines (11th and 12th in L.D.) the following: "thence north thirty degrees, forty minutes, fifty-one seconds east (N 30° 40' 51" E)" and inserting in its place the following: "thence north thirty-one degrees, forty minutes, fifty-one seconds east (N 31° 40' 51" E)"

Statement of Fact

This amendment will have no effect on the location of the line or monuments as they appear on the face of the earth. This change will denote the proper bearing of that section of the Brewer-Holden town line.
