COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 810, L.D. 985, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Hiring of Bus Drivers by School Administrative Districts."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA §2013, sub-§1, ¶E, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 780, §4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

Application for such examination shall be filed within 2 days after commencement of such operation.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce from 10 to 2 the number of days after beginning to operate a bus that the driver has before he must apply for an examination to operate the vehicle used as a school bus.
