HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 818,
L.D. 991, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for no Smoking Areas in All
State Offices."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §§1578 to 1582 are enacted to read: §1578. Purposes'

Further amend the amendment in the 3rd paragraph in the first line by striking out the underlined figures and word "1577 to 1581" and inserting in its place the underlined figures and word '1578 to 1582'

Further amend the amendment in the 3rd paragraph in the last line by striking out the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1578." and inserting in its place the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1579."

Further amend the amendment in the 4th paragraph in the first line by striking out the underlined figures and word "1577 to 1581" and inserting in its place the underlined figures and word '1578 to 1582'

Further amend the amendment in the 6th paragraph in the last line by striking out the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1579." and inserting in its place the following underlined symbol, figures and punctuation '§1580.'

Further amend the amendment in the 7th paragraph in the last line by striking out the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1580." and inserting in its place the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1581."

Further amend the amendment in the 9th paragraph in the last line by striking out the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1581." and inserting in its place the underlined symbol, figures and punctuation "§1582."

Statement of Fact

This amendment is presented on behalf of the House Committee on Bills in the Second Reading to clear up potential conflicts between this bill and other legislation. This amendment merely renumbers the sections of the original bill. It is essential that this amendment be adopted to prevent conflicts from being enacted in the statutes.
