STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Sentencing for a Person Committing a Criminal Homicide in the 2nd Degree.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 17-A MRSA § 1251, sub-§ 3, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 499, § 1, is amended to read:
- 3. Upon receipt of the report and recommendations provided for in subsection 2, the court shall sentence him to the State Prison for any term of years that is not less than 20 25.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for a minimum 25-year sentence for 2nd degree homicide.
