AN ACT to Establish Maine Writers Week.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

1 MRSA § 112-A is enacted to read:

§ 112-A. Maine Writers Week

The State of Maine designates the week commencing with the 2nd Sunday of October of each year as **Maine Writers Week**, recommending that in this week schools, churches, libraries, clubs and organizations, the newspapers, radio and television give recognition to the writers who have helped or are helping to make Maine famous in the field of literature throughout the world.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes Maine Writers Week in recognition of the contributions made by Maine writers.
