STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Sheriff of Cumberland County to \$15,000 per Year.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, 4th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 767, § 3, is further amended to read:

Cumberland County: County commissioners, \$5,787; clerk of courts, \$10,634; deputy clerk of courts, \$9,969; county treasurer, \$9,969; sheriff, \$15,000; register of deeds, \$9,969; deputy register of deeds, \$7,975; judge of probate, \$12,020; register of probate, \$9,820;

Sec. 2. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall take effect January 1, 1978.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the Sheriff of Cumberland County to \$15,000, effective January 1, 1978.
