HOUSE AMENDMENT "**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 762, L.D. 1012, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Employment
Security Law to Include Federal Requirements and other
Options Available to the State."

Amend the Amendment in section 21 in subsection 7
by inserting at the end the following:

'D. However, employing units may elect to allow
benefits to be paid to employees performing the
services described in paragraphs B and C. The costs
shall not be shared by other employing units who do
not allow the benefits.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the employing
unit the option of whether or not certain school employees
should be eligible for benefits during school breaks. This
would apply to the following school personnel.

1. Paragraph B. Nonprofessional employees of
secondary and elementary schools during term breaks, i.e.,
over the summer; and

2. Paragraph C: Professional college employees and
nonprofessional employees of secondary and elementary
schools during school vacations.

Because the state funds approximately 50% of the cost of education in the organized territory and 100% of the cost in the unorganized territory, this amendment might result in an expenditure of state funds.
