SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 927, L.D. 1017, Resolve,
Authorizing the Commissioner of Conservation to Convey Land to
Somerset County Formerly Known as the Women's Correctional
Center at Skowhegan."

Amend the Resolve by striking out all of the emergency
preamble and emergency clause.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike the emergency
preamble and emergency clause. The Maine Constitution provides
that an emergency bill shall not include provision for the sale
or purchase or renting for more than five years of real estate.
