COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 311, L.D. 1031, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Certified Interpreter Service for the Hearing
Impaired."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Provide Certified Deaf and Interpreter Service for the/Hearing Impaired.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§48."

by striking out all of the first line and inserting in its place the following:

'§48. Interpreter service for the deaf and hearing impaired'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§48."

in subsection 2 in the first line (same in L.D.) by striking

out the underlined word "interpretations" and inserting in its

place the underlined word 'interpreters'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§48." in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (2nd line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "mannual" and inserting in its place the underlined word 'manual'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment includes the word "deaf" in the title of the bill and in the headnote of Title 5, section 48. The amendment also makes minor technical changes for the purposes of clarifying the bill.
