### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish the Right of Municipalities to Raise More as Well as Less Money in the Town Warrants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 30 MRSA § 2052, sub-§ 2 is amended to read:
- 2. Business to be acted upon. It shall state in distinct articles the business to be acted upon at the meeting, and no other business may be acted upon, except that nothing in this section shall prevent a municipality from voting to raise a sum of money which is larger or smaller than a sum set out in any article of the warrant.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would permit a municipality voting on the articles in a warrant to raise a sum greater or smaller than that set out in any article.
