HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 845, L.D. 1036, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit the Use of Headphones While Operating a Motor Vehicle."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§1000." in the first indented paragraph in the first line after the underlined word "vehicle" the underlined words 'on a public way'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§1000." in the first indented paragraph by adding after the underlined words and punctuation "the vehicle." the following underlined sentence:

'This section shall not apply to operators of heavy equipment or of motor vehicles in which the use of headphones or noise suppressor headsets is recommended by the manufacturer of the equipment or motor vehicle or by other federal or state regulations.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts from the bill operators of heavy equipment or of motor vehicles where the use of headphones or noise suppressor headsets is recommended.
