COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 851, L.D. 1042, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Taxable Personal Property."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'36 MRSA §655, sub-§1, ¶P is enacted to read:

P. All items of individually-owned personal property
with a just value of less than \$1,000 not used for
industrial or commercial purposes and not specifically
enumerated in section 603.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to simplify the
administration of the taxation of personal property by
exempting such property with a value of less than \$1,000.
