STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Eliminate an Exception to the Statutory Requirement that Financial Institutions have Deposit Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

9-B MRSA § 422, sub-§ 1, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 670, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate discretionary waiver by the Superintendent of Banking of the requirement of federal deposit insurance for financial institutions with assets of less than \$250,000. The bill will assure such insurance for deposits in all financial institutions, without exception.
