STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Restrict Election Day Political Activities Near Voter Registration Offices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 21 MRSA § 892-A is enacted to read:
- § 892-A. Influence near voter registration office.

A person shall not influence or attempt to influence another as to his choice of candidates within 100 feet of any voter registration office.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits influencing of a person as to his choice of candidate within 100 feet of any voter registration office.
