HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 869, L.D. 1062, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Licenses for
Camping Areas and Eating Establishments."

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the
title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause
and inserting in its place the following:

22 MRSA §2495, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 496,
§3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The department shall, within 30 days following receipt
of application, issue a license to operate any eating
establishment, eating and lodging place, lodging place,
recreational camp, camping area or mobile home park which is
found to comply with this chapter and any rules and regulations
adopted by the department, and has submitted documented proof
of compliance with all local ordinances relating to the
operation of the facility for which the license application has
been made.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the term 'public health' which clarifies
the application of the Act as there are some areas that do not
have public health ordinances.
