COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 869, L.D. 1062, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning Licenses for Camping Areas and Eating  
Establishments."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §2495, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 496,  
§3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

The department shall, within 30 days following receipt of  
application, issue a license to operate any eating establishment,  
eating and lodging place, lodging place, recreational camp,  
camping area or mobile home park which is found to comply with  
this chapter and any rules and regulations adopted by the department  
and has submitted documented proof of compliance with all local  
ordinances relating to the operation of the  
facility for which the license application has been made.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that any  
applicant for a license under Title 12, chapter 562, Camping  
Areas and Eating Establishments, shall be required to submit  
documented proof that he is in compliance with all local public  
health ordinances relating to the operation of the facility  
for which the license is sought.
