STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Licenses for Camping Areas and Eating Establishments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 2495, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 496, § 3, is amended to read:

The department shall, within 30 days following receipt of application, issue a license to operate any eating establishment, eating and lodging place, lodging place, recreational camp, camping area or mobile home park which is found to comply with this chapter, all state laws and local ordinances and any rules and regulations adopted by the department.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the department to refuse to issue a license to anyone found to be violating a state law or local ordinance not specified under Title 22, chapter 562.
