COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 870, L.D. 1063, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for 4-Year Terms of Office for Representatives,
Governors and Lieutenant Governors of the Passamaquoddy Tribe
of Indians."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the 4th line of section 2
the underlined figure "1980" and inserting in its place the
underlined figure '1978'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change from 1980 to
1978 the year that the provisions of the bill first apply to
Passamaquoddy elections for governor, lieutenant governor and
representative to the Legislature. The change must be made so
that the year coincides with the next election.
