COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 879, L.D. 1070, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Consideration of the Economic Impact of Decisions made by the Board of Environmental Protection."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and insert in its place the following:

'38 MRS §361, as last amended by PL 1975, c.771, §419, is further amended by inserting after the 8th paragraph a new paragraph to read:

Before making decisions authorized by this section, the board may receive testimony on the economic effect of any proposed project for which a permit is required and any proposed regulation.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will permit the Board of Environmental Protection to receive testimony of the economic effect of its decisions authorized by Title 38, section 361.
