HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1019, L.D. 1073, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning the Retirement Law Relating to Certain
Employees of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in paragraph F in the 10th
line (8th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined
word "retired" the underlined words 'on or after the attainment
of age 50'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 3
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund to the State Retirement System the sum of \$946,750
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be
as follows:

STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM		
Retirement Allowance Fund		
All Other	\$405,750	\$541,000

Provides funds for 20-year retirement for personnel of correctional
and juvenile institutions and State Division of Probation and
Parole.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will require in addition to the other
provisions of the bill that the employees may be retired on
or after the attainment of age 50.
