STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Require the Public Utilities Commission to Conduct a Study of Telephone Rate Structures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Telephone rate structure; study. The Public Utilities Commission is authorized and directed to conduct a study of the current rate structures of utilities furnishing telephone service within the State, to determine if rates being charged by those utilities are reasonable. The Public Utilities Commission shall report its findings to the Legislature, along with any and all recommendations, not later than 30 legislative days following the convening of the second regular session of the 108th Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would require the Public Utilities Commission to conduct a study of telephone rates being charged within the State and to report its findings to the 108th Legislature.
