**AN ACT to Authorize a Feasibility Study for a Lewiston River Road from  
Lewiston to Lisbon.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Lewiston River Road; study authorized.** The Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to make a study of the feasibility and cost of a proposed highway between the municipalities of Lewiston and Lisbon, in the County of Androscoggin.

**Sec. 2. Report.** The department shall report the results of its study at the next regular session of the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would authorize the Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility study for the proposed Lewiston River Road from Lewiston to Lisbon and to report its findings at the next regular session of the Legislature.
