HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 877, L.D. 1102, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning County Contingent Funds and the Rate of Interest Which May be Charged for Delinquent County Taxes."

Amend the Bill by striking out at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the first sentence after the amending clause of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'This fund shall be used for emergency purposes only at the discretion of the county commissioners with reasonable notice to the members of the legislative delegation from that county.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit the county commissioners to exercise their discretion on the use of the fund for emergency purposes provided they give reasonable notice to members of the legislative delegation from that county of such action.
