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**AN ACT to Correct the Used Car Information Law.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

to MRSA § 1474, sub-§ 1, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 770, § 57, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

As originally enacted, this bill gave purchasers of used cars information concerning the history of the vehicle and a guarantee that at the time of sale the vehicle met the inspection standards imposed by Maine law. The purpose of this bill is to repeal an amendment to the law that is not only inconsistent with other provisions of the bill but also gives the used car purchaser less rights than he had at common law.
