COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 907, L.D. 1106, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning the per Pupil Cost of a School Administrative  
Unit Losing More than 33% of its Enrollment between June and  
September."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 20 MRSA §3748, sub-§3, ¶G is enacted to read:

G. Any administrative unit which experiences a  
decrease in enrollment in either elementary or  
secondary education programs of 33% or greater  
between April 1st of the base year and October  
1st of the year prior to the year of the alloca-  
tion of funds shall at a minimum be eligible to  
have its subsidy based on the basic elementary  
or secondary per pupil operating rate.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the  
Department of Educational and Cultural Services from the General  
Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978, the sum of \$76,671.31  
to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as  
follows:

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide an appropriation to reimburse units which have experienced a 33% decrease in enrollment within the last year.
