**AN ACT Concerning the per Pupil Cost of a School Administrative Unit
Losing More than 33% of its Enrollment between June and September.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 3748, sub-§ 3, ¶ G is enacted to read:

G. Any administrative unit which loses more than 33% of its enrollment between June and September of a given year in either its elementary or secondary programs shall use its current year's actual per pupil operating cost figures for allocation purposes.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that school administrative units suffering a drop in enrollment of more than 33% between June and September of any year shall use its current year's actual per pupil operating cost figures for allocation purposes. This would assist schools with a large number of tuition students which lose these students during any year.
