AN ACT to Annex Certain Territories to the Town of Howland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain territories annexed to Town of Howland. The following territory which lies north of the following described line shall be annexed and become a part of the Town of Howland: Beginning at a point on the west bank of the Penobscot River on the line between the river lots numbered 23 and 24 in said town, thence on said line to the westerly end of said lots, thence continuing the same course of said lot line to the westerly line of said town, thence northeasterly on said line to the Penobscot River, thence southwesterly by said river to the first mentioned bounds.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would annex Mattamiscontis, which was part of Howland until 1839, to the Town of Howland.
