STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Prohibit the Importation of Nuclear Waste into the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

10 MRSA § 105 is enacted to read:

§ 105. Nuclear waste

It shall be unlawful to import any radioactive or nuclear materials into the State for the purpose of final dumping and disposal.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 17-A, violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$50,000, or imprisonment for a term not to exceed 10 years, or both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would make it unlawful to import radioactive or nuclear materials into the State for dumping or disposal. Those convicted of violation of this law would be punished by a fine of not less than \$50,000, or imprisonment for not more than 10 years, or both.
