and Replace it With a Fee for Inspection and to Specify
Certain Offenses Concerning the Sale of Marine Worms and
Other Commodities."

Amend the Amendment in section 2 in that part first underlined designated "<u>\$4301-D.</u>" by striking out all of the/2nd sentence of the underlined paragraph of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'All diggers shall count all marine worms sold to dealers and shall place such worms in containers provided by the dealer.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment removes a requirement that worm diggers count their worms in the dealer's facilities.
