HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
913, L.D. 1119, Bill, "AN ACT to Eliminate Tax on Marine Worms  
and Replace it With a Fee for Inspection and to Specify  
Certain Offenses Concerning the Sale of Marine Worms and  
Other Commodities."

Amend the Amendment in section 2 in that part  
designated "§4301-D." by striking out all of the <sup>first underlined</sup> 2nd <sup>sentence of</sup>  
underlined paragraph of subsection 1 and inserting in its  
place the following:

'All diggers shall count all marine worms sold to dealers  
and shall place such worms in containers provided by the  
dealer.'

This amendment removes a requirement that worm diggers  
count their worms in the dealer's facilities.
